Group Highlights 2009

- Successful incorporation of ANZGOG to a public not-for-profit company.
- Recruitment for 2009 currently stands at 108 patients.
- Tripod met its recruitment target and closes to further accrual today with 39 patients enrolled.
- The Symptom Benefit study has 54 patients enrolled and will transition to Stage 2 in early 2010 with a number of GCIG groups planning to participate.
- The OVAR16 clinical trial opened to recruitment. We have thirteen sites active to date and fourteen patients enrolled.
- The inaugural ANZGOG/ASGO Annual Scientific Meeting met all expectations of being an extremely inspirational, educational and social conference.
- A successful ANZGOG Strategic Planning Meeting was held to brainstorm ideas to ensure our future viability and growth.
