- 3. The nominated trial site/team must have a track record of effectively meeting the requirements of the National Clinical Trials Governance Framework.
- 4. The Site nomination must have two nominees supporting the Award A nomination by the Site PI or study Chair and a Senior Hospital Administrator endorsing the nomination.
- 5. The nomination must include a reason why you are nominating the site (Maximum 300 words).
